Rules and Regulations

- Cookies are judged on appearance and taste. Points will be given for neatness, originality, creativity, colors, and degree of difficulty.
- All cookies are to be round in shape and less than 3 inches. The challenge is to showcase at least 2 different ways to decorate a cookie based on one cut-out shape. 2 cookies will be for display. 2 cookies will be for judging. All need to be uniform.
- Cookies may be decorated in buttercream, royal icing, chocolate, or any combination.
- The cookies will be judged based on appearance and taste; however, all ingredients and decorations used must be edible.
- Cookie shapes may be altered up to 5% from the original cut-out shape.
- Only edible decorations and embellishments are allowed. Use of inedible decorations may result in a penalty score or disqualification.
- Cookies must not infringe the copyright, trademark, privacy, publicity or other intellectual
 property rights of any person or entity. Cookies that violate this requirement will be
 disqualified from the competition.
- Cookies must be already baked, assembled, decorated, and ready for viewing when entered
- Containers and displays can be picked up after Monday, September 1st at 9pm. We will only hold for a week.
- All work is to be done in a professional manner.
